

Mr. President,

All human rights, are a crucial lever for responding to and rescuing the 2030 Agenda.

Today's crises highlight the urgency of taking integrated approaches, in terms of realizing both human rights and the SDGs.

Unless the world can reverse the current global trajectory of climate change, the attainment of the Sustainable Development Goals will be compromised.

LDCs should not be left behind, and for that reason OIPMA recommend the following key measures:

The cooperation between the high-level political forum on sustainable development and the Human Rights Council must be enhanced.

The HLPF and regional, national and local mechanisms monitoring the SDGs should make use of recommendations emanating from the United Nations human rights system.

States in LDCs should reinforce the integration of the analysis and recommendations of the UN human rights mechanisms into their voluntary national reviews and national development strategies and plans.

The UN human rights mechanisms should continue to provide guidance and recommendations for LDCs who left behind and design policies to achieve inclusive and sustainable development.
