Mr. President,

Some of LDCs face challenges of Conflict Prevention, Post-Conflict Peace building and Promotion of Durable Peace, Rule of Law and Governance.

Facts and events have already proven that, Achievement of the SDGs has been hampered by violence, conflict, extremism, intolerance, hatred and terrorism and a lack of rule of law and weak institutions.

Yemen, is an example, where the Huthis and the Muslim Brotherhood imposes extremism, intolerance, hatred and terrorism and using violence to gain power. As a result, the young generation is suffering from these phenomena.

For that reason, it is essential that, capacity building should address the root causes of these phenomena by providing opportunities to the young generation, which will improve their quality of life and reduce their vulnerability to extremist ideologies, and helps to promote long-term sustainable development.

Capacity building requires a multifaceted approach that includes promoting tolerance, addressing social and political grievances, and countering extremist ideologies, by working together across different communities, institutions, and nations, we can overcome the challenge of terrorism and build safer, more peaceful LDCs.
